This will confirm our telephone conference on June 9, 1993, at which time we requested that the advisory opinion for the <u>Duncan for Congress</u>, <u>Inc.</u> also address the issue as to whether the corporation can make contributions to political candidates on a local, state, and national basis.

We anticipate that approximately 50% of the contributions will be made to political parties and 50% to political candidates with a large part of these contributions going to the Knox County Republican ticket. In the average year, we anticipate that the corporation would make contributions to political parties and candidates in the range of \$5,000.00 to \$10,000.00. Please advise whether the amounts of these contributions raise any specific problems.
