Dear Mr. Noble:

We are writing to request an advisory opinion regarding the use of a mobile home during a congressional campaign.

The mobile home is owned by Woodly Combs Auto Sales and Leasing. The candidate, Patrick J. Combs, and his father Forestt "Woody" Combs are general partners and the sole owners of this business. The campaign leases the mobile home to the Patrick Combs for Congress campaign at the fair market rate.

Are we allowed to operate the mobile home for limited campaign purposes using "dealer plates" obtained by Woody Combs Anto Sales and Leasing without running the risk of violating any federal election laws?

Please advise.
