Dear Mr. Marinelli:

I write to respond to your recent inquiry by telephone regarding the above-captioned Advisory Opinion request.

I wish to affirm that the member of AHCA's Board of Directors to be elected by the proposed Associate Business Members will have the same voting rights as any other member of AHCA's Board of Directors. Additionally, that board member, as well as the two additional representatives to be elected by the proposed Associate Business Members, all three of whom will be members of AHCA's House of Delegates, will have the same voting rights as any other member of AHCA's House of Delegates. I believe that this is clear under the proposed amendments to AHCA's Constitution and Bylaws, which provide that such elected board member and additional representatives shall be members of the Board of Directors and House of Delegates, respectively, and which do not otherwise indicate any difference in voting rights therein.
