Alexander for President, Inc., the principal campaign committee advocating the obsticity Lamar Alexander of Tennessee to the Presidency of the United States (the "Committee"), seeks an advisory opinion as to whether the Committee may use the Internet, the World Wide Web, and related technology (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Internet") to solicit contributions on behalf of Governor Alexander's candidacy. In making this request, the Committee takes note of and makes reference to Advisory Opinion 1995-9 dated April 21, 1995, in which the Commission concluded that a political action committee ("NewtWatch") may, observing the restrictions set forth therein, solicit and accept contributions over the Internet. Except as noted specifically herein, the Committee will observe the restrictions set forth in Advisory Opinion 1995-9 in making its proposed Internet solicitations.

The Committee has not settled on an actual text for the proposed solicitations, but it contemplates making only a generic statement that supporters of Governor Alexander can contribute to the Committee by sending personal checks to the Treasurer of the Committee at Committee headquarters. (Unlike NewtWatch, the Committee will not solicit or accept contributions made by credit cards, electronic transfers or other electronic means. The Committee will solicit and accept only contributions made by natural persons who are not "foreign nationals" as defined in 2 U. S. C. 441(e) and drawn on personal checks, its intent being that all such contributions will be "matchable contributions" under 11 C. F. R. 9034.2.) The Internet solicitation message will also include the disclaimers required by federal election law and Internal Revenue Service regulations to the effect that the solicitation is paid for by the Committee; that contributions are not deductible for federal income tax purposes; and that the Committee must report the identity, mailing address, occupation, and name of employer for individuals whose contribution aggregate more than \$200 in a calendar year. (The solicitation will also include the Committee's standard disclaimer that it cannot accept corporate contributions.) Thus, the Internet solicitations will not differ in any material way from the Committee's direct mail solicitations (a sample of which is enclosed).

Finance Office 1808 West End Avenue, Suite 928 Nashville, Tennessee 37203 615/327-3270 Fax 615/327-1480 Once a contribution made in response to the Internet solicitation arrives at the Committee headquarters, the Treasurer will process the contribution as he does any other contribution that arrives without a response card, i.e., he will send a "follow up" mailing to the contributor attempting to ascertain his name, mailing address, occupation, name of employer, and telephone number. The Committee does not plan to obtain this information through 'e-mail' or other electronic means.

The Committee believes that soliciting and processing Internet contributions will differ in no material way from contributions that it solicits and processes through direct mail. It further believes that it can carry out the Internet solicitations without accepting contributions from prohibited sources, excessive contributions, or contributions in the name of another. The Committee therefore respectfully requests that you approve its proposed use of the Internet to solicit contributions and, to the extent that the provisions of Advisory Opinion 1995-9 apply to the Committee's proposed solicitations, that the Committee be permitted to rely on that Opinion.


