Pursuant to our November 21, 1996 telephone conversation, I understand that the Office of General Counsel and the Commission will not be able to conclude their consideration of the Advisory Opinion Request that we submitted on behalf of our client, PRIMECO Personal Communications, L.P. ("PrimeCo") on November 8, 1996 ("AOR 1996-49"), before expiration of the 60-day time period set forth in 2 U.S.C. §437f.

This letter confirms that, on behalf of PrimeCo, I have consented and waive any objections to the Commission's further consideration of AOR 1996-49 after January 7, 1997.
