

Dear Jan.

We propose the following measures to ensure that only personal funds, and no corporate funds, are used for the new solicitation program we are considering:

- 1) Only residential consumers will be solicited. (Generally, rural electric cooperatives classify their membership into at least three categories: residential, commercial and industrial. The majority of our consumers are residential.)
- 2) Residential members using capital credits for their contribution will be asked to affirm that all of their previous contributions were made with personal (non-corporate) funds.
- 3) Residential members contributing other than by capital credits will be asked to affirm that these are from personal (non-corporate) funds.
- 4) In all solicitations, a clear disclaimer that corporate funds are not permitted will be included.
