**Michael** - Attached with this cover letter is a re-fax of both the NM Affiliation Agreement and the WA letter of support for the Green Party filing. They are the same as the ones faxed earlier, but are being faxed together for your convenience. Hardcopies of both of these are being dropped into the mail to you today.

We have tracked down the New York Green fusion candidates, and it appears that two are supportive of the filing. They have been sent an affidavit and we are awaiting their return. The KY Green Party needs a state meeting to consider the request, so it is unlikely that we will receive anything from them in time for the filing.

The Green Party is comfortable with the submission of the AOR with just the NM and WA materials as supplements. We will attempt to supplement further with the NY fusion candidate affidavits, but we'd like you to move ahead without them, if necessary.

**OFFICIAL AFFILIATION AGREEMENT**

**BETWEEN  
The Green Party of New Mexico  
AND  
The Association of State Green Parties**

**BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** this 27<sup>th</sup> day of September 1997 that the Green Party of New Mexico (NMGP) agrees to formally affiliate with the Association of State Green Parties, and formally agrees to abide by the provisional Bylaws of the Association.

It is understood that the NMGP shall appoint two delegates from New Mexico to represent the NMGP on the Coordinating/Steering Committee of the Association. It is also understood that these two representatives should be gender balanced.

It is also agreed that the undersigned NMGP reserves all rights and powers to the NMGP that are not given, through the provisional Bylaws of the Association, to the Association of State Green Parties.

It is also agreed that the NMGP will continue to conduct voter registration drives in the State of New Mexico.

It is also agreed that the NMGP will use its best efforts to support ballot access for national candidates nominated by the Association of State Green Parties and candidates nominated by the NMGP.

It is also agreed that the NMGP will conduct a State convention, at minimum, once each election year.

It is also agreed that the NMGP will solicit contributions for State, local and national Green Party candidates.

It is also agreed that the NMGP will make its best efforts to nominate candidates for State, local and federal offices.

It is also agreed that the NMGP shall operate according to the bylaws of the NMGP as filed with New Mexico's Secretary of State.

The following representatives of the NMGP, acting pursuant to the Bylaws of the Green Party of New Mexico, swear that they are empowered to enter into this affiliation agreement with the Association of State Green Parties.
