In our recent telephone conversation, you provided us with additional information regarding Advisory Opinion Request 2012-26 (Cooper for Congress, ArmourMedia, Inc., and m-Qube, Inc.). We have set out below our understanding of the information provided during the conversation. Please either confirm the accuracy of this statement or correct any misperceptions.

Question 4 of the advisory opinion request asks whether Cooper for Congress may participate in a short code program without receiving an in-kind contribution if the wireless service providers establish objective and commercially reasonable criteria for participation by political committees.
