SUBJECT: MUR 7374 (Wright 2016)
Pre-Probable Cause Conciliation Agreement

On April 26, 2018, the Commission found reason to believe that Wright 2016 and Charlette Mimiassie in her official capacity as treasurer ("Committee") violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30116(f) and 30118(a) by failing to timely refund, redesignate, or reattribute \$9,250 in excessive and prohibited 2016 primary election contributions and by failing to timely refund \$117,450 in 2016 general election contributions after the candidate's loss in the primary election.¹ The Commission also voted to enter into pre-probable cause conciliation with the Committee.
