All of our campaign commercials had PAID FOR BY WOLF 2018 for at least four seconds as required. Sometimes it was at the beginning AND at the end so as to ensure we were compliant. We ran advertisements on NBC and worked with the sales people who also ensured that our digital ads were in full compliance with state and federal regulations.
