Campaign signs without the "paid for by" language
Congressional election in Pennsylvania's new district 01

To the Office of Complaints Examination and Legal Administration:

Thank you for your correspondence dated May 17, 2018 confirming receipt of my complaint. I do have some additional information that may be of use in your investigation into the signs that appeared across Bucks County about Scott Wallace that have no "paid for by" language. While most if not all of the signs have disappeared from the streets of our district in the wake of the primary election, there is reason to believe that they will influence the general election and may make a reappearance later in the campaign season.

The losing candidate from the Republican side of the primary campaign, Dean Malik, has announced his intention to create a political action committee. Please find attached an article from the *Levittown Now*, a local paper, on the creation of "bucksPAC," Dean Malik's new organization. The contact information for this new PAC, as noted on their Facebook page is:

I have also included a printout from the "bucksPAC" facebook page. The very first meme that the group posted after the creation of their Facebook presence was an image of one of the campaign signs that are the subject of this investigation.

Additionally, Mr. Malik recently appeared on an area talk radio show, The Tom Giordano Program on 1210 AM. During that audio interview, Mr. Malik cites the exact talking points that are promoted on the signs under investigation. At the 4:07 mark of the recording, Mr. Malik echoes the claim that the candidate gave \$25,000 to the county Democratic party to acquire the nomination.

I have also included the printout of another Facebook thread that has information and images about these signs continuing to be posted in the days immediately before the Pennsylvania primary. Over 30 of them were pulled on or immediately before May 12, 2018 from locations throughout central Bucks County.

Malik said Wallace, a millionaire philanthropist, is "unrelatable" to many First Congressional District voters and doesn't connect with the "hard working people of Levittown and Bucks County." He added that he thinks his PAC can focus on keeping the First Congressional District in Republican control.

The Doylestown attorney said he thinks the GOP can win the November election by talking to voters and putting boots on the ground.

Malik earned just over 30 percent of the Republican votes during the primary last week.
