MUR 7436 (Warrior PAC, et al.) - Pre-Probable Cause

Conciliation

Attorney

 On July, 17, 2018, the Commission found reason to believe that Warrior PAC and its treasurer in his official capacity ("Committee") violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(g) by failing to timely file four 48-hour independent expenditure reports totaling \$604,662.40, and authorized pre-probable cause conciliation with an opening settlement offer of \$60,000.\(^1\) Attached is a conciliation agreement negotiated with the Committee that, if approved, would resolve the violations.\(^2\) Under the specific facts of this case, we recommend that the Commission approve this agreement.
