On September 28, 2016, Vincent Barletta and certain Barletta-controlled entities notified the Federal Election Commission ("Commission"), in a *sua sponte* submission, of potential violations of certain provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). Your clients were notified as respondents on December 21, 2016. Upon further review of the Submission, and information supplied by your clients, the Commission, on August 7, 2018, voted to take no action as to Dallas Babineau, Linda Brown, Leonard Brown, John Dargin, Thomas Day, Anne-Marie Gardella, Daniel Gardella, Kevin Huie, Martin Naughton, Ryan Ondejko and Christopher Spencer and close the file as to these individuals.

Please be advised that the Act prohibits a person from knowingly permitting his/her name to be used to make a contribution in the name of another. 52 U.S.C. § 30122 and 11 C.F.R. § 110.4(b)(1)(ii). The Commission cautions your clients to take steps to ensure that their conduct is in compliance with the Act and the Commission regulations.

You are advised that the confidentiality provisions of 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(12)(A) remain in effect, and that this matter is still open with respect to other respondents. The Commission will notify you when the entire file has been closed.
